Directions for Submission of Poster Proposal:

Submissions should be based on recent research or quality improvement projects related to the health care field. Submissions must include a completed [application form](#) and a [one-page abstract form](#), no more than 300 words.

Abstracts must be received at posterapplication@umcsn.com by June 18. Proposals submitted after the deadline will not be considered by the Poster Program Committee.

- All poster submissions will be reviewed by the Poster Program Committee. Accepted posters must be presented by at least one of the authors during the poster session on November 13 at noon.
- The winning poster(s) will be selected by a neutral panel of judges using the following six criteria: Is the poster visually appealing? Is the content clear and easy to follow? Is the purpose clearly stated? Is the poster understandable and relevant to nursing or the health care field? Is the project/research creative and/or innovative? Does it add knowledge to the discipline?
- All submissions should be current research within the past two years. All submissions must be free of commercial interest. Commercial interest organizations are not eligible to submit abstracts. An individual must disclose any financial relationship with an entity with a commercial interest.
- Size: Posters dimensions are three feet by two feet. Orientation: Landscape.
- Please send any questions to posterapplication@umcsn.com. If your poster is accepted, you will be notified by July 10. Completed posters are due on August 27.

USE OF CONTENT AND AI GENERATED IMAGES

Disclosure Requirement: Authors must clearly state when AI-generated images are used, such as a brief note in the figure caption: "Image generated using Chat GPT." Always specify the AI platform or tool used.

Content Review: All AI-generated images should go through the same departmental or committee review as traditional graphics to ensure accuracy, appropriateness, and consistency with the scientific message.

Limited Use: Limit AI-generated images to conceptual, illustrative or background visuals (such as stylized artistic elements), rather than data, clinical images or direct scientific evidence. AI-generated images must not replace real research results, patient images, or datasets.

Documentation: Save a record of the prompts and outputs used to generate the AI content and submit the information via email to posterapplication@umcsn.com to ensure transparency.
